**Angelic Recipe**

**FROSTY ORANGE DREAM SQUARES**



40 Nilla Vanilla wafers, finely crushed (about 1-1/2 cups)  
1/4 cup butter, melted  
2 cups cold milk  
2 pks (4-serving size each) Jell-O Vanilla Instant Pudding  
3 cups thawed Cool Whip, divided (I split the entire tub in half)  
2 cups orange sherbet, softened

Line 13x9 pan with foil, ends extending over sides of pan. Mix wafer crumbs with butter. Press firmly onto bottom of pan.

Add milk to dry pudding mixes in medium bowl. Beat with wire whisk 2 min or until well blended. Gently stir in half of the topping. Spoon evenly over crust. Refrigerate 10 min. Add remaining topping to sherbet; stir with wire whisk until well blended. Spoon evenly over pudding layer; cover.

Freeze at least 3 hrs or overnight. Use foil handles to remove dessert from pan before cutting into squares to serve. Store leftover dessert in freezer.

**BBQ:**



This year, Americans will grill a combined 2,957,000,000 times. Grill owners fire up their grills twice a week in the summer. 11% of grill owners received their grills as gifts. According to the Weber Grill Company, over 5,000,000 hot dogs are expected to be eaten between Memorial Day and Labor Day. Close to 4,700,000 hamburgers will be eaten during this same time period with mustard being the number one condiment on both. The top BBQ sauces are hickory, tomato-based, honey and mesquite.

According to a new Weber Grill survey, hamburgers (64 percent) will be the most grilled item over Memorial Day followed by steak (46 percent), chicken pieces (40 percent), and hot dogs (34 percent), ribs (14 percent), and bratwurst (13 percent). Other findings:

51% of women, as opposed to 44% of men, make their own bbq sauce. In addition, charcoal owners (53 percent) are more likely than gas owners (47 percent) to have whipped up a homemade barbecue sauce.
