**LAW OF BIOMECHANICS:** The severity of the itch is inversely proportional to the reach.

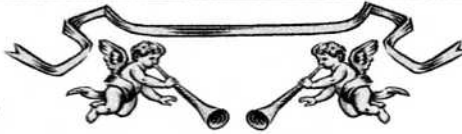
**THEATRE RULE:** People with the seats at the furthest from the aisle arrive last.
