Angelic Recipe

Pasta Chicken



Ingredients:

- 4 chicken breasts - diced up into bite size pieces
- 1 bunch of broccoli (or 10 oz frozen chopped) - diced up into bite sized pieces
- 5 to 10 garlic cloves - minced or pressed
- basil & oregano - to taste (approx. 1/2 tsp each)
- 1 medium carton, Half and Half
- 4 large ripe tomatoes
- 1 10oz pack of small shell pasta
- olive oil
- grated parmesan cheese - to taste

Directions:

In a large pot, boil water. When boiling, add pasta and cooked until done, drain pasta. Cook broccoli.

Brown chicken pieces in olive oil, add tomatoes and garlic, and simmer for approx 3 minutes. Add basil and oregano and simmer again for 2 to 3 minutes.

Add Half and Half. Simmer again for 3 to 7 minutes. Add pasta and parmesan cheese, stir well and serve.

It's great served with French or garlic bread and a salad.
