**Angelic Recipe**

**Carrot Cake II**

- 2 c. self-rising flour
- 2 c. sugar
- 1 1/2 c. cooking oil
- 4 eggs
- 3 c. carrots, grated



2 tbsp. cinnamon

Combine sugar and oil; add flour and eggs, one at a time, beating until blended. Batter will be stiff. Add carrots and cinnamon. Pour into floured greased pans and bake at 350 degrees 35 to 40 minutes until cake springs back when touched. This can be baked in 2 (9 inch) pans or 3 (8 inch) pans.

**ICING:**

- 1 (8 oz.) pkg. cream cheese
- 1 stick margarine
- 1 box confectioners sugar
- 1 tbsp. vanilla
- 1 c. pecans, chopped

Soften cream cheese and margarine; mix well. Add other ingredients.
