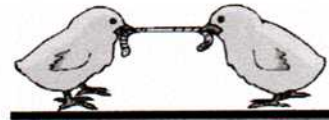

Angelic Recipe

Simple Spinach Dip Recipe

INGREDIENTS

- * 1 10-oz. package frozen chopped spinach
- * 6 slices crumbled crisp bacon
- * 1 8-oz. package cream cheese
- * 1/2 cup mayonnaise
- * 2 tbsp minced onions
- * 1/3 cup Parmesan cheese
- * 2 tbsp lemon juice
- * 1 loaf of bread (rye or pumpernickel), unsliced
- * 1 tbsp dill weed (optional)

DIRECTIONS

Thaw spinach in microwave. Squeeze out water. Mix all ingredients in a bowl. Hollow out the middle of the bread. Put aside chunks of bread. Place spinach dip in hollowed bread. Place chunks of bread or assorted crackers around the bread and serve.
